EVENTS FOR EVERYONE

- Secure sponsorships with the Comms & Marketing Officer to reduce ticket prices
- and expand student nightlife deals across Dublin
- Introduce an Ents loyalty scheme with presales, early access, and reduced ticket prices for regular attendees
- Prioritise commuter-friendly start times and publish key events in advance to support travel planning
- Collaborate with Mature Students Society and ESN to deliver events that work for mature and international students respectively, with accessible timings and inclusive formats

EMPOWERING STUDENTS & COLLABORATION

- Empower the Ents Committee with real autonomy, training, and accountability to lead events
- Work closely with Class Reps, clubs, and societies to align event calendars, avoid clashes, and actively promote their events - particularly those led by underrepresented societies and minority groups
- Ensure diverse lineups that showcase Trinity's musicians and DJs across all genres
- Shape Ents with student voice through a permanent feedback and reporting form

CULTURAL INCLUSION

- Deliver bilingual Ents communications and ticketing in Irish and English
- Organise a Gaeltacht trip to give students first-hand experience of Irish-speaking culture
- Create a consistent timetable of non-alcoholic daytime events - coffee mornings, snack breaks, sober raves and live music - including a weekly Society Day led by underrepresented societies

WELFARE & ACCESSIBILITY

- Run a series of safety and Dublin nightlife awareness sessions with the Welfare & Equality Officer each semester
- Continue pushing venues to meet real accessibility standards and publish clear accessibility information in advance
- Consult disability services and advocate for practical supports, such as SU funding
- for a portable ramp

PAV & T-BALL

- Campaign for improved crowd control at the Pav, including staffing, queue management, and capacity enforcement
- Introduce post-Pav Friday club nights one or two times per semester
- Establish a dedicated Pav-Fest Committee with clear responsibilities to ensure consistency year on year
- Continue pushing for a high-quality T-BALL line-up while ensuring strong security and crowd control
