Press Release on the tabling of a GSU motion to divest from TCDSU.

Trinity College Dublin Students' Union are disappointed to see a motion tabled by the Graduate Students' Union calling for their divestment from TCDSU. A decision such as this would greatly limit the ability of both unions to effectively cooperate in representing all students within the college.

TCDSU has a constitutional obligation to represent the interests and provide services to all students in Trinity College Dublin. Postgraduate representation within TCDSU has, historically, been fulfilled by a long-standing Memorandum of Agreement between TCDSU and GSU. Going forward, if this Memorandum fails to be renewed, TCDSU is committed to investigating and updating our officership structures to fulfil our representative duties to the Postgraduate Community.

Regardless of the outcome of this motion, TCDSU will continue to endeavour to represent all students.
